Just call from a touch-tone phone to 1-800-4-1-VOICE, ext. 359 (418-6423) to leave your information. Or text 66746 then type TIPS. Your message will not be traced, and you will not be identified. The Safe School Helpline® team will transcribe and email/text your message to school officials, so appropriate action can be taken.
